HIGHLIGHT




We also added two new full-time maintenance technicians, Carson Cox and Jacob Hatfield.



Facilities welcomes all of our new part-time help.


On the top left we have our two new maintenance techs, Dallin Richens and Lourdes Ruiz.

On the top right is Richard Cressall and Dallin Robins who joined the custodial crew last month.


On the bottom right is Mercedes Skaggs and Preston Henke who joined us this month!




MAINTENANCE


