



Application for Curatorial Agreement

The Prehistoric Museum will serve as a repository for archaeological and paleontological collections under the following conditions:

1. Curatorial agreements with the Prehistoric Museum must be renewed annually.
2. All specimens and collections are legally collected, and the Prehistoric Museum is harmless from all claims.
3. Specimens obtained from state or public lands are the property of that agency, and are being repositied with the permission of that agency.
4. In keeping with the Prehistoric Museum mission and bylaws, collections will normally be accepted only from sites in Carbon, Emery, Duchesne, Uintah, Grand, Wayne, Garfield, Kane and San Juan counties in eastern Utah. Other collections aligned with the Prehistoric Museum mission may be accepted with special consent.
5. Depositors must comply with all applicable procedures for fees, labels, packaging, documentation and repositing collections in the Prehistoric Museum Curation Guidelines.
